We always try and meet individual choices of our students, and the timetable for these A Level choices is rewritten each year in order to meet such requests.

In past years we have been able to accommodate other subjects and individual students have taken GCSEs in astronomy, Greek and Italian.

We also encourage Sixth Form to take part in the Open University Young Applicants in School Scheme (YASS) which allows students to take OU courses at first year undergraduate level alongside their AS levels. This gives talented and motivated students the chance to experience study at higher education level. The OU offers a wide range of courses with a timescale that varies from 12 weeks to 9 months, with subjects ranging from astronomy to digital photography.

Sixth Form Entry Requirements

Students are normally expected to have gained at least grade B in 5 subjects at GCSE including those they intend to study at A Level. At least grade C in Maths and English at GCSE is required. Prior to entry all students are invited to an interview at which intended courses and any variation to the chosen programme or entry requirements will be discussed. Sixth Form Scholarships are available.
