



Drama in Alice House and Junior School

Right from the start each pupil's work is valued, whether that work is spoken or performed. In Alice House all girls take part in role-play and from Nursery onwards regularly share their daily news with an audience of peers and teachers. Class performances, assemblies and the annual Nativity play give all girls an opportunity to perform for their parents.
